In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus offers a powerful reminder that our faith is lived not only in prayer and worship, but in the way we treat those around us. He tells us that whenever we feed the hungry, welcome the stranger, care for the sick, or visit the lonely, we do these things for Him.

This teaching challenges us to look beyond appearances and recognise the dignity of every person we meet. Christ is present in the vulnerable, the overlooked, and those in need of kindness and compassion. Our daily acts of generosity, however small they may seem, become opportunities to encounter the Lord Himself.

As we begin this week, may we ask for the grace to see Christ in one another and to respond with loving hearts. Through simple acts of service, understanding, and welcome, we help to build God's kingdom here among us.

Parish Giving Scheme

We are pleased to announce that our Parish Giving Scheme (PGS) is now active. The PGS is a secure and simplified method of giving to the church, improving cash flow, reducing administrative tasks, and allowing flexibility for donors. All current forms of giving also remain.

Donations are directed to our Parish via the scheme with Gift Aid claimed on a regular rather than annual basis. Donors can make regular or one-off contributions and choose whether to opt into yearly inflation-based increases. The scheme is provided free of charge via the Diocese, and the Parish will receive 100% of any donation.

Alaa Abdel Fattah – Endured 11 years of wrongful imprisonment in Egypt who we prayed for in April 2025 was released in September 2025

Sonia Dahmani – Was sentenced and imprisoned for Human Rights protests in Tunisia in May 2024. We prayed for her in September 2025 and she was released in November that year.

Maryia Kalesnikava was imprisoned in Belarus in 2021 for 11 years on fabricated charges. We prayed for her in October 2025 and she was released in December 2025.
