This Sunday's readings invite us to consider the condition of our hearts. St Paul reminds us that in Christ there is "no condemnation" for those who live according to the Spirit rather than the selfish desires of the flesh. God's Spirit dwells within us, bringing freedom, life and hope.

In the Gospel, Jesus tells the Parable of the Sower. The seed is generously scattered, but its fruit depends on the soil in which it falls. The same Word of God is offered to each of us. Are our hearts hardened by distraction, shallow in commitment, crowded by worry and material concerns, or open and receptive to God's grace?

Let us ask the Holy Spirit to prepare the soil of our hearts. May we welcome God's Word with faith, allow it to take deep root within us, and bear the abundant fruits of love, mercy, and faithful discipleship in our daily lives.

Parish Giving Scheme

We are pleased to announce that our Parish Giving Scheme (PGS) is now active. The PGS is a secure and simplified method of giving to the church, improving cash flow, reducing administrative tasks, and allowing flexibility for donors. All current forms of giving also remain.

Donations are directed to our Parish via the scheme with Gift Aid claimed on a regular rather than annual basis. Donors can make regular or one-off contributions and choose whether to opt into yearly inflation-based increases. The scheme is provided free of charge via the Diocese, and the Parish will receive 100% of any donation.

Prisoner of Conscience: Iranian Christian convert Mary Mohammadi (27), who is a well-known human rights defender and journalist and a former prisoner of conscience, disappeared in late February and has not been heard from since then. She was in communication with her family after travelling from Tehran to Ahvaz in Iran, until around 26 February, when contact abruptly ceased. It is believed that she is being unlawfully detained by the Iranian authorities.
