Prisoner of Conscience: Maria Ponomarenko, 46, a journalist with online media RusNews, was sentenced on 15th February 2023 to six years' imprisonment under the Russian Criminal Code for a social media post condemning the Russian strike on the drama theatre in Mariupol, Ukraine, many civilians were sheltering. Maria is serving her sentence in penal colony IK-6, 175 km from Barnaul, southern Siberia, where she has faced ill-treatment, including placements in a disciplinary cell, solitary confinement and denial of adequate healthcare.

Thank you to everyone who attended our Annual Meeting last Sunday, it was good to see so many people.

We are very fortunate that 2 people, Les Allen and Russell Goodburn, were elected as Church Wardens for the Parish. Welcome Russell and Les, thank you for standing to serve in this role.

Thank you too, to Katharine Lobo and Walter Mennie who were elected as PCC members, and we have nominations from Michael Mortimer and Steph Littlejohn.

Questions were asked about:

Holy Trinity roof repairs – we are holding funds of approximately £89,000 towards the cost of the remaining roof repairs. The cost of these repairs is not yet known, updates will be given as the project progresses

Holy Trinity Choir – the choir is open for anyone to join. Services are being developed which include a variety of musical styles in Holy Trinity.

Suggestions for charities to support in the next 2 years were collected. Congregations will be asked for further ideas on 30th March, these will be discussed and charities selected by PCC in
