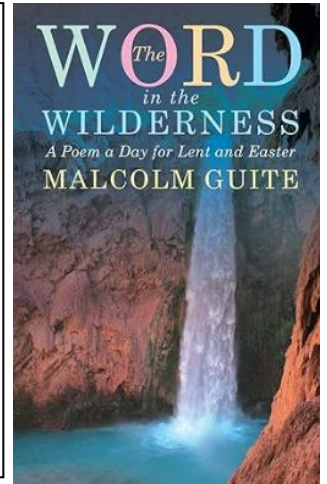
Holy Week is an intense time in the Christian Calendar.
