Prisoner of Conscience – in this fortnight we think of:

Naser Navard Gol-Tapeh (63) who had been on hunger strike in Tehran's Evin Prison for 35 days protesting against the continued systematic persecution of Christians in Iran. He suffered a stroke and on 17 March he was found unconscious in his prison cell. He was treated in hospital but despite his poor physical condition, Naser was discharged from hospital after two days and returned to prison. He continues to have limited movement in his left side, but has ended his hunger strike.
