Prisoner of Conscience: Christian convert Aida Najaflou (43) who was arrested at her parents' home in Tehran on 6 February and taken to Evin Prison, controlled by the Ministry of Intelligence. On 13 April, she was transferred to the women's ward of the prison, where she remains because her family cannot afford the bail set for her, equivalent to around €115,000. She is facing charges of "acting against national security" and "propaganda against the regime" because she is a Christian convert. Aida has ongoing spinal problems requiring continuous medical attention which she is being denied.
