As we journey through the week beginning **15<sup>th</sup> February**, the Church invites us to pause and contemplate the **Transfiguration of the Lord**. On the mountain, Jesus is revealed in radiant glory, offering the disciples a glimpse of who He truly is—God’s beloved Son, bringing light into every shadow. This moment of transformation was not only for their reassurance, but for ours as well.

The Transfiguration speaks deeply to our own need for **spiritual healing**. It reminds us that God meets us where we are, yet lovingly calls us to be changed—renewed in faith, hope, and love. In times of weariness, doubt, or quiet suffering, Christ’s light continues to shine, restoring what feels broken and strengthening what feels weak.

As we listen again to the Father’s words, *“This is my Son, the Beloved; listen to him,”* may we open our hearts to healing grace. May this week be a time of renewal, as we allow Christ to transform us from within and lead us forward in trust and peace.

**Prisoner of Conscience:** Former nurse and mother-of-four Shagufta Kiran (42) was arrested in Pakistan’s capital Islamabad in July 2021 after she was accused of forwarding a WhatsApp message that contained blasphemy. Since her arrest she has been imprisoned in Rawalpindi’s Adiala Central Jail and her case hearings were repeatedly adjourned until September 2024, when she was sentenced to death. She remains in prison with no date for an appeal. We last prayed for Shagufta in March last year.
